AN ORDINANCE to authorise the Mayor, Aldermen and
Citizens of the City of Port-of-Spain to raise certain
moneys for defraying the expenses of improvement
in the City of Port-of-Spain.

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port-of-Spain Short Title.
Improvement Loan Ordinance, 1939.

Authority to
raise loan.

2. The Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Port-of-Spain (hereinafter referred to as the Corporation) may raise by loan an amount sufficient to produce as nearly as may be the sum of six hundred and eighty-two thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven dollars and such further sum as may be necessary to defray the expenses of raising such loan.

Application
of loan.

3. (1) Any sum raised to defray the expenses of raising the loan shall be applied only to that purpose.

(2) Save as aforesaid the money borrowed under this Ordinance shall be appropriated and applied to the purposes specified in the Schedule to this Ordinance:

Provided that it shall be lawful for the Corporation with the prior sanction of the Governor in Council to utilize any sums not required in respect of one of the items in the said Schedule for the purposes of any other or others of those items.

Method of
raising loan.

4. The loan hereby authorised or any part of it shall be raised in the Colony under the provisions of the General Local Loan (Municipal Corporations) Ordinance, 1935.

Contribution
to Sinking
Fund.

5. The contribution to Sinking Fund, as contemplated by the provisions of the General Local Loan (Municipal Corporations) Ordinance, 1935, shall commence in respect of any issue under this Ordinance not later than one year after the date from which the interest on such issue shall commence to run.

Apportion-
ment of
interest and
Sinking Fund

6. The amounts appropriated annually under the provisions of section 14 of the General Local Loan (Municipal Corporations) Ordinance, 1935, shall be apportioned between General Purposes, Waterworks, and Sewerage Works revenue in the ratio which the expenditure incurred upon General Purposes Improvement Works, Waterworks Improvement Works, and Sewerage Works Improvement Works respectively bears to the total expenditure incurred.

7. The Port-of-Spain Improvement Loan Ordinance, 1935, is hereby amended by deleting the following from the Schedule thereto:—

Belmont Drainage Scheme	\$48,000
Purchase of 35, Frederick Street	\$12,480

and by altering the total amount of the loan mentioned in section 2 thereof and also in the Schedule thereto from four hundred and forty-six thousand four hundred dollars to three hundred and eighty-five thousand nine hundred and twenty dollars.

8. Pending the issue of the whole or any portion of the loan hereby authorised, the Governor may, if necessary, by warrant under his hand, authorise the Treasurer to make advances to be applied to the purposes in the Schedule to this Ordinance.
