2. Section 132 of the Electric Lighting and Tramways Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following :—

Recovery of
penalties.

132. All penalties under this Ordinance or any rule or regulation made in pursuance of this Ordinance may be recovered and enforced in a summary manner before a Magistrate, and the procedure in any such case shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance.
