AN ORDINANCE to amend the Immigration (Restriction)
Ordinance, 1936.

[12th September, 1939.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Immigration Short title.
(Restriction) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1939, and shall be
read as one with the Immigration (Restriction) Ordinance, Construction.
1936, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Principal Ordinance, the Governor may in his absolute discretion prohibit the entry of any alien into the Colony.

Section 27 of
the Principal
Ordinance
amended.

3. Section 27 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph—

(f) being a prohibited immigrant, disembarks in the Colony without previously obtaining a permit issued under this Ordinance.
