AN ORDINANCE to make provision for defraying the
expenses of the Government of the Colony of Trinidad
and Tobago for the year 1940.

[1st January, 1940]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Short title.
Ordinance, 1939, and shall come into operation on the
1st January, 1940.

Providing for
payment from
public funds.

2. There may be issued and paid from and out of the Public Moneys of the Colony of Trinidad and Tobago for the service of the year 1940, an amount not exceeding the following sums, that is to say:—
