Minimum Penalties and Fines (Removal).

AN ORDINANCE for the removal of minimum penalties
and fines.

[20th December, 1941.]

Commencement.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Minimum Penalties and Fines (Removal) Ordinance, 1941. Short title.

2. Whenever in any Ordinance in force at the commencement of this Ordinance, or in any rule, regulation or bye-law made under any Ordinance and in force at the commencement of this Ordinance, provision is made for any minimum penalty or fine, or for any fixed penalty or fine, as a punishment for a criminal offence, such Ordinance, rule, regulation or bye-law shall have effect as though no such minimum penalty or fine had been provided, or as though the fixed penalty or fine was the maximum penalty or fine, as the case may be : Provided that this Ordinance shall be without prejudice to any penalty or fine imposed before the commencement of this Ordinance.
