Herbert Stephen Pension.

AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of a pension to Herbert Stephen.

[31st December, 1941.]

Commencement.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Herbert Stephen Pension Ordinance, 1941. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Pensions Ordinance, and in the Pensions Regulations, it shall be lawful to reckon service as Attendant at the Detention Station (Leper Settlement) at Cocorite as being service in a pensionable office Grade I for the purpose of computing the pension that may be granted to Herbert Stephen in respect of his service with the Government of the Colony, but for no other purpose.
