AN ORDINANCE to amend the Electric Lighting and  
Tramways Ordinance, Cap. 310.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows :—

Short title.  
Construction.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Electric Lighting  
and Tramways (Amendment) Ordinance, 1937, and shall  
be read as one with the Electric Lighting and Tramways  
Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal  
Ordinance.

Routes.

2. Section 74 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby  
repealed and replaced by the following :

74. The routes to be followed by the said  
tramways and the nature of the lines to be  
constructed, shall be as severally defined and  
described in the Fifth Schedule: Provided that  
it shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive  
Council, on the application of the undertakers, to  
authorise and empower the undertakers to  
discontinue the working of such tramways or of any  
part thereof. Every such application shall be  
published by the undertakers in the *Royal Gazette*  
and in at least one local newspaper for at least  
one month previous to the same being granted by  
the Governor in Council.

3. Section 99 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following :

99.—(1) The undertakers may demand levy receive and take in respect of the said tramways and the operation thereof for every passenger travelling and for any freight carried upon any of the cars and carriages of the tramways authorised by or under the provisions of this Ordinance such tolls, fares, rates, or charges as may from time to time be fixed by them with the approval of the Governor in Executive Council. A list of the tolls and fares for passengers and charges for freight so approved by the Governor in Executive Council shall be exhibited in a conspicuous place inside of each of the carriages or cars used upon the said tramways and in the offices of the undertakers and such list shall be published in the *Royal Gazette*.

Charges

(2) Production of a copy of the *Royal Gazette* purporting to contain the list of tolls, fares, rates or charges fixed by the undertakers with the approval of the Governor in Executive Council shall be sufficient evidence that such list was approved in manner provided by this Ordinance.

(3) The following persons shall be carried free :

- (a) The Director of Works and Transport and the City Engineer ;
- (b) Constables and firemen (not exceeding three in any car at one time) when on duty or in uniform provided that they shall sit on the three rear seats of a car if seating accommodation on such rear seats is available.

4. The Sixth Schedule of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.
