AN ORDINANCE to amend the Trinidad Electricity  
Board Ordinance, 1935.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Trinidad Electricity Board (Amendment) Ordinance, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Trinidad Electricity Board Ordinance, 1935, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance
2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto after Section 7 the following new Section as Section 7A.

7A. It shall be lawful for the Board, with the approval of and subject to such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Governor in Executive Council, to provide for the establishment and maintenance of a Provident Fund for the benefit of the officers and servants of the Board and for that purpose to make arrangements with such Insurance Company or Companies as may be selected by the Governor in Executive Council.
