AN ORDINANCE to amend the Trinidad Electricity  
Board Ordinance, 1935.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Trinidad Short title.  
Electricity Board (Amendment) Ordinance, 1936, and Construction.  
shall be read as one with the Trinidad Electricity Board No. 39 of 1935  
Ordinance, 1935, hereinafter referred to as the Principal  
Ordinance.

2. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Section 4 of  
Ord. 39-1935  
amended.  
amended as follows :—

(a) by adding at the end of sub-section (3) the  
following: "The Governor in Executive Council  
may remove from office any nominee of the  
Port-of-Spain Corporation upon a request to  
that effect submitted by the Council of the  
Corporation, and may remove any other member  
of the Board if he considers it desirable so  
to do."
