AN ORDINANCE to amend the Gasworks  
Ordinance, 1928.

**W**HEREAS Ordinance No. 35 of 1932, intituled the  
Gasworks (Amendment) Ordinance, 1932, extended  
the time for payment of certain deposits to 30th June, 1936;

And whereas it has not been possible for the reasons  
set out in the Company's petition presented to the  
Legislative Council on the 27th March, 1936, for the  
Undertakers to obtain the necessary capital in the United  
Kingdom, Canada or this Colony and to pay the deposits  
before the said 30th June, 1936, and the said Undertakers  
are desirous that the time limit fixed should be extended to  
the 30th June, 1938;

And whereas it is expedient that the said time limit  
should be further extended;
