AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pensions Ordinance, 1934.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions Short title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1936, and shall be construed as Construction.  
one with the Pensions Ordinance, 1934, hereinafter No. 16-1934.  
referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Sub-sections (2) and (3) of Section 8 of the Principal Section 8  
of Ord. 16  
of 1934  
amended.  
Ordinance are hereby repealed and in lieu thereof there shall be substituted the following sub-section, namely:

(2) Where it is established to the satisfaction of the Governor in Executive Council that an officer has been guilty of negligence, irregularity or misconduct, the pension, gratuity or other allowance may be reduced or altogether withheld.
