AN ORDINANCE to amend and to continue in force
the Mortgages Extension Ordinance, 1934.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

Short title. **1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Mortgages Extension (Amendment) Ordinance, 1938.

Amendment of section 8 of Ordinance No. 12 of 1934. **2.** Section 8 of the Mortgages Extension Ordinance, 1934, is amended by adding at the end of sub-section (e) thereof the words "where the Governor has given a direction under the provisions of section 19 of the Agricultural Industry Hurricane Relief Ordinance, 1933, or"

Continuance of Ordinance No. 12 of 1934. **3.**—(1) The Mortgages Extension Ordinance, 1934, shall continue in force until the 31st day of December, 1940, and shall then expire unless further continued.

(2) Section 13 of the Mortgages Extension Ordinance, 1934, is amended accordingly.
