AN ORDINANCE to amend the Dangerous Drugs
Ordinance, 1928.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

Short title.

No. 28 of 1928.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1938, and shall be read as one
with the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1928, hereinafter
referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 8 of
the Principal
Ordinance
amended.

2. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended
by adding thereto the following paragraph:—

(h) attends or is present on any premises whilst such
premises are actually being used for the purpose
of opium smoking, unless he satisfies the Court
that he had a lawful excuse for being on such
premises.
