AN ORDINANCE to amend the Diseases of Animals  
Ordinance, Cap. 256.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Diseases of Short Title.  
Animals (Amendment) Ordinance, 1938.

2. The Diseases of Animals Ordinance is hereby amended Secs. 7, 8, and  
9 of Cap. 256  
amended.  
by substituting the words "Senior Veterinary Officer" for  
the words "Governor in Executive Council" appearing in  
sections 7 and 9 thereof; and by deleting the words  
"in Executive Council" appearing in the first line of  
section 8 thereof.
