AN ORDINANCE to amend the Petroleum Office and  
Conservation Board Ordinance, 1938.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Petroleum Office Short Title.  
and Conservation Board (Amendment) Ordinance, 1938,  
and shall be construed as one with the Petroleum Office Construction.  
and Conservation Board Ordinance, 1938, hereinafter No. 4 of 1938.  
referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended Section 2 of  
by deleting the definition of "Banker's Guarantee" and Principal  
substituting therefor the following:— Ordinance  
amended.

"Guarantee" means a guarantee or bond given—

- (a) by a person licensed to carry on the business  
of banking in the Colony under the Bankers'  
Licences and Bank notes (Duties) Ordinance, No. 40 of 1932  
1932; or

- (b) by an Insurance or Guarantee Company registered in this Colony under the Companies Ordinance, and approved by the Treasurer for the purpose of giving guarantees under this Ordinance; or
- (c) by the deposit of securities approved by the Treasurer.

Principal Ordinance amended.

3. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the word "Banker's" wherever the same occurs in section 6 of the said Ordinance and in the Schedule thereto.

Section 6 of Principal Ordinance amended.

4. The following sub-section numbered (6) shall be added to and form part of section 6 of the Principal Ordinance:

(6) Whenever a Guarantee consists of securities such securities or any part thereof may with the consent of the Treasurer be deposited with the Crown Agents who shall hold the same at the disposal of the Treasurer.
