AN ORDINANCE to amend the Corporal Punishment  
Ordinance, Cap. 33.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Corporal Punishment (Amendment) Ordinance, 1935, and shall be construed as one with the Corporal Punishment Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following words at the end thereof "or that the offender committed or attempted to commit an assault involving the use of any corrosive fluid with intent to disfigure or do any grievous bodily harm to any person or had in his possession such fluid with such intent and for the purposes aforesaid."
