AN ORDINANCE to amend the Judicature Ordinance,  
Cap. 35.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Judicature Short title, (Amendment) Ordinance, 1934, and shall be construed as one with the Judicature Ordinance, hereinafter referred to Construction. as the Principal Ordinance. Cap. 35.

2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended Amendment of by the deletion of the whole of the last sentence commencing Section 5 of with the words "The acceptance by any Judge . . ." Principal and by the substitution therefor of the following sentence:— Ordinance.

"No Judge shall accept or perform any other office or place of profit or emolument not authorized by law without the consent of the Governor: Provided that this restriction shall not apply to a Judge temporarily appointed to act as such under section 7 of this Ordinance.
