AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Library Ordinance,
Cap. 289.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title. **1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Library (Amendment) Ordinance, 1934, and shall be construed as one with the Public Library Ordinance, Cap. 289, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and shall commence on the 1st day of January, 1935.

Construction. **2.** Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance as amended by the Public Library (Amendment) Ordinance, 1931, is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

Repeal and re-enactment of s. 5 of Principal Ordinance. Constitution of Committee of Management.

5 (1) The Library shall be managed and controlled by a Committee of Management which shall be constituted as follows:—

(a) Four members to be appointed once in every three years or at any time to fill a vacancy in any such appointment, by the Governor

(b) Four members to be appointed annually or at any time to fill a vacancy in any such appointment, by the City Council.

(c) Four members to be elected at the Annual General Meeting or at any time to fill a vacancy, by the subscribers.

(2) Any subscriber for a period of not less than 12 months prior to the Annual General Meeting shall have the right to vote and be eligible for election to the Committee, provided that no member of the Committee shall be required to pay any subscription whatever during his tenure of office.

(3) The Secretary shall summon a Meeting of the Committee to be held not less than once during every month. Any member failing to attend three consecutive monthly meetings shall *ipso facto* vacate his appointment or election, as the case may be, unless leave of absence has been granted by the Committee to such member or such default has, in the opinion of the Committee, been due to reasonable cause.

3. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of the last sentence and in lieu thereof shall be read the following: " Provided always that no person shall serve as Chairman for more than three years in succession."
