AN ORDINANCE to amend the Education Ordinance, 1933.

**BE** it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Education (Amendment) Ordinance, 1934, and shall be construed as one with and commence on the same date as the Education Ordinance, 1933, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title. Construction of s. 16 (2) of Principal Ordinance. Commencement. (No. 23 of 1933.)

**2.** Sub-section (2) of Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following words, "controlled by the Department". Amendment of s. 16 (2) of Principal Ordinance.

**3.** Sub-section (4) of Section 23 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words "the rate of" and substituting in lieu thereof the words "a rate not exceeding". Amendment of s. 23 (4) of Principal Ordinance.

4. Section 28 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting after the words "in the service of the Government" the following words "or during service as a teacher under the Principal Ordinance, or of any person who at the time of his death was in receipt of a pension payable in accordance with the provisions of the School Teachers' Pensions Ordinance, 1929 or the Pensions Ordinance, 1934".
