AN ORDINANCE to amend the Constabulary Ordinance  
Cap. 88.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Constabulary Short title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1936, and shall be construed  
as one with the Constabulary Ordinance, Cap. 88, herein- Construction.  
after referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Sub-section (3) of Section 32 of the Principal Ordinance Amendment  
of s. 32 of  
Cap. 88.  
is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“(3) The Governor may at any time dismiss from  
the Force or dispense with the services of any  
warrant or non-commissioned officer or constable  
whom he may consider unfit for further service  
in the Force :
