AN ORDINANCE to amend the Firearms Ordinance, Cap. 259.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Ordinance, 1935.

Amendment
of s. 2 of
Cap. 259.

2. The definition of "Firearms" in section 2 of the Firearms Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words "by means of an explosive substance" at the end of the definition and by inserting in lieu thereof the following words "but does not include a toy gun or toy pistol".
