AN ORDINANCE to amend the Deep Water Harbour
Loan Ordinance, 1934 (No. 3 of 1934).

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

Short title. **1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Deep Water
Harbour Loan (Amendment) Ordinance, 1935, and shall
Construction. be read as one with the Deep Water Harbour Loan
Ordinance, 1934, hereinafter referred to as the Principal
Ordinance.

Section 4 of

expenses. **2.** The following paragraph shall be added to and form
part of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance :—

The money to be borrowed under the Authority
of this Ordinance shall also be appropriated and
applied to the following purposes incidental to the
construction of the Deep Water Harbour, namely :—

- (a) The purchase of such dredgers, tugs and other
equipment which may be required and used
not only for the construction of the Deep Water
Harbour but for the subsequent maintenance
of the said Harbour ;

- (b) Reclamation works along, over, and adjacent to the foreshore of any part of the Harbour of Port-of-Spain;
 - (c) The payment of compensation to owners of land injuriously affected by the construction of the Deep Water Harbour and the reclamation works, and of the value of any interest or rights which may be acquired in any such land.

Passed in Council this fifth day of July, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five.
