AN ORDINANCE to authorize the Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Port-of-Spain to raise certain moneys for defraying the expenses of improvements in the City of Port-of-Spain.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title      1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port-of-Spain Improvement Loan Ordinance, 1935.

Authority to raise loan.      2.—(1) It shall be lawful for the Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Port-of-Spain (hereinafter called the Corporation) from time to time to take up by way of loan such sums of money as will be sufficient to produce as nearly as may be the amount of four hundred and forty-six thousand, four hundred dollars and such further sums as may be necessary to defray the expenses of raising such loan.

(2) The money to be borrowed under the authority of this Ordinance shall be appropriated and applied to the purposes specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance; provided that it shall be lawful for the Corporation with the sanction of the Governor in Executive Council to utilize any sums not required in respect of one of the items in the said Schedule for the purposes of any other items.

3. The loan hereby authorized or any part of it shall be raised in the Colony under the provisions of the General Local Loan (Municipal Corporations) Ordinance, 1935. Method of raising the loan.

4. The contribution to Sinking Fund, as contemplated by the provisions of the General Local Loan (Municipal Corporations) Ordinance, 1935, shall commence in respect of any issue under this Ordinance not later than one year after the date from which the interest on such issue shall commence to run. Contribution to Sinking Fund.

5. The amounts appropriated annually under the provisions of section 14 of the General Local Loan (Municipal Corporations) Ordinance, 1935, shall be apportioned between General Purposes, and Waterworks revenue in the ratio which the expenditure incurred upon General Purposes Improvement Works and Waterworks Improvement Works respectively bears to the total expenditure incurred. Apportionment of interest and sinking fund charges.

6. The Port-of-Spain Improvement Loan Ordinance, 1933, is hereby repealed. Repeal. (No. 14 of 1933).
