AN ORDINANCE to amend the Constabulary Ordinance,
Cap. 88.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Constabulary Short title.
