AN ORDINANCE to amend the District Waterworks Ordinance, Cap. 114.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the District Water-^{Short title.}works (Amendment) Ordinance, 1934, and shall be construed as one with the District Waterworks Ordinance, ^{Construction.}hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion after paragraph (i) of ^{Amendment of s. 6 (1) of Cap. 114.}a new paragraph (j) as follows and by renaming the subsequent paragraphs (k) and (l) respectively :—

“(j) The payment by the Maintenance Authority of pensions and gratuities to the officers and servants of the Authority in such circumstances and subject to such conditions as may be prescribed.”
