AN ORDINANCE to make provision for raising a loan
for the construction of a deep water Harbour at
Port-of-Spain.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Deep water Short title.
Harbour Loan Ordinance, 1934.

2. The Governor is hereby authorised to raise a loan of Authority to

an amount sufficient to produce as nearly as may be the
sum of One Million Pounds sterling and such further sum
as may be necessary to defray the expenses of issue.

3. The loan hereby authorised or any part of it may Method of

be raised in London under the provisions of the General
Loan and Inscribed Stock Ordinance.

4. The money to be borrowed under the authority of this Ordinance shall be appropriated and applied to the construction of a Deep Water Harbour at Port-of-Spain and the provision and equipment of quays, wharves, warehouses and other buildings and works required in connection therewith.

5. The contribution to Sinking Fund, as contemplated by the provisions of sections 13 and 27 of the General Loan and Inscribed Stock Ordinance shall commence in respect of any issue under this Ordinance not later than one year after the construction of the said Deep Water Harbour and buildings and works is completed.

6. Pending the issue of the whole or any portion of the loan hereby authorised the Governor may, if necessary, raise instalments of the money as required by issue of Treasury Bills under the Treasury Bills Ordinance.
