AN ORDINANCE to amend the Poor Relief Ordinance, 1930 (No. 22 of 1930).

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Poor Relief Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1934, and shall be construed as Construction. one with the Poor Relief Ordinance, 1930, hereinafter (No 22-1930). referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended Amendments to s. 9 of the Principal Ordinance. as follows:—

(a) In sub-section (2) thereof the whole of the first sentence is hereby repealed and replaced as follows:

“The Local Board shall consist of a Warden or an Assistant Warden, to be appointed by the Governor, who shall be Chairman, and of not more than five other persons to be nominated by the Governor, who shall hold office during his pleasure and for a period of not more than three years.”

(b) In sub-section (3) thereof by deletion of the words
“ including the Chairman ”.

(c) By the addition of the following sub-section :—

“ (5) Notwithstanding the provisions
of sub-section (2) of this section, the
members present at any meeting may, in
the unavoidable absence of the Warden or
Assistant Warden, elect any member to act
as **Chairman** of such meeting.”

Passed in Council this ninth day of March, in
the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and
thirty-four.
