AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pensions Ordinance,
Cap. 83.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1933, and shall be construed as one with the Pensions Ordinance, Cap. 83, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance, and shall come into operation Commence-
ment. on such day as may be fixed by the Governor by proclamation.

2. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary Saving as to
s. 8 (a) of the
Principal
Ordinance. contained in section 8 (a) of the Principal Ordinance (which is set out in section 5 of the Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1927) any officer specified in the Schedule to (7 of 1927.) this Ordinance shall be deemed to have duly exercised the option referred to in sub-section (1) of such section.

(2) The Governor in Executive Council may with the approval of the Secretary of State amend the said Schedule from time to time by Proclamation adding thereto the name of any officer whom he is satisfied has inadvertently omitted to exercise such option within the period prescribed.
