## AN ORDINANCE to amend the Oil and Water Board Ordinance, Cap. 148.

 $B^{\rm E}$  it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :---

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Oil and Water short title. Board (Amendment) Ordinance, 1933.

**2.** Section 2 of the Oil and Water Board Ordinance is  $\frac{1}{148}$  hereby amended by the addition of the following definition :  $\frac{1}{148}$ .

"Oil mining operations" includes the mining winning and refining of crude oil and any subsidiary operations carried out for the recovery and disposal of any products of crude oil;".
