AN ORDINANCE to amend the Oil and Water Board
Ordinance, Cap. 148.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Oil and Water Short title.
Board (Amendment) Ordinance, 1933.

2. Section 2 of the Oil and Water Board Ordinance is Amendment
hereby amended by the addition of the following definition : of s. 2 of
Cap. 148.

“Oil mining operations” includes the mining
winning and refining of crude oil and any
subsidiary operations carried out for the recovery
and disposal of any products of crude oil;”.
