AN ORDINANCE to amend the Arima Markets Ordinance,
Cap. 236.

[14th December, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Arima Markets Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1933, and shall be construed as Construction.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended Amendment

3. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraph:—

(10) "Prohibiting, restricting or controlling the introduction of fresh meat for sale in the Borough."

4 Sections 15 and 16 of the Principal Ordinance are hereby repealed and the following sections substituted therefor:—

Licence to sell
meat, premises
to be licensed
and licence to
sell
marketable
commodities.

15. (1) It shall not be lawful for any person—

(a) to sell or offer or expose for sale fresh meat within the Borough or within half a mile of any part of the limits thereof unless such person is authorized so to do by a licence issued by the Council;

(b) to sell or offer or expose for sale fresh meat in any shop or premises within the Borough or within half a mile from any part of the limits thereof (except in a market) unless such shop or premises are licensed for the purpose by the Council;

(c) to sell or offer or expose for sale any marketable commodities in any shop or premises or in any street or public place within the Borough or within half a mile of any part of the limits thereof (except in a market) unless such person is authorized so to do by a licence issued by the Council.

(2) Every person who shall act in contravention of the provisions of sub-section (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and be liable to a penalty not exceeding five pounds for each such offence.

16. Licences granted under paragraphs (a) and (c) of sub-section (1) of the preceding section shall not be transferable and all licences shall be granted for such period, on payment of such sums and upon such terms and conditions as the Council may by bye-laws prescribe and shall be revocable by the Council on breach by the licensee of any of the conditions subject to which such licences shall be granted.

5.—(1) Sections 9 and 17 of the Principal Ordinance are hereby amended by inserting the words “fresh meat or” before the words “marketable commodities” wheresoever they occur. Amendment of sections 9 and 17 of the Principal Ordinance

(2) Sub-section (3) of section 9 is hereby amended by deleting the words “distress and sale” and substituting therefor the words “seizure and immediate sale”.
