AN ORDINANCE to provide for the change of titles of officers.

[14th November, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Officers Short title.  
(Change of Titles) Ordinance, 1933 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 16th day of October, 1933. Commencement.

2. Whenever the title of the Public Officers set out in the first column of the Schedule hereto appears in any Ordinance, Order-in-Executive Council, Proclamation, Rule, Regulation, Bye-law, Order or Notice now in force, it shall be deemed to be replaced by the corresponding title set out in the second column of the said Schedule. Substitution of new titles for those of General Manager of Railways and Director of Public Works.

Whenever any change of title of any Public Officer occurs at any future time, the Governor in Executive Council, if occasion requires, may by Proclamation in the *Royal Gazette* make any necessary substitution in or addition to the said Schedule and the provisions of section 2 of this Ordinance shall apply accordingly in conformity with every such substitution or addition.
