AN ORDINANCE to amend the Cinematograph (British  
Films) Ordinance, 1932 (No. 41 of 1932).

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Cinematograph Short title.  
(British Films) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1933, shall be  
construed as one with the Cinematograph (British Films) Construction.  
Ordinance, 1932, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance,  
and shall come into operation on the day fixed for the Commence-  
ment.  
commencement of the Principal Ordinance.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance Amendment of  
s. 5 (1) of  
Ord. 41  
of 1932.  
is hereby amended by deleting the last sentence thereof  
and substituting therefor the following :—

An exhibitor who exhibits news films shall exhibit  
such proportion of British news films as is shown  
in the 3rd column of the Schedule to this  
Ordinance in such manner and at such times or  
periods as the Governor in Executive Council  
may prescribe.
