AN ORDINANCE to amend the Building Societies Ordinance,
Ch. 38. No. 1.

[1st January, 1958]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Building Societies
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1958, and shall be read as one with
the Building Societies Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the
Principal Ordinance.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1958.

2. Subsection (2) of section 45 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“Duties of
auditors.

(2) Every auditor, in attesting any such annual account or statement, shall—

- (a) verify that it is correct, duly vouched, and in accordance with law, or specially report to the society in what respect he finds it incorrect, unvouched, or not in accordance with law; and
- (b) certify that he has at that audit actually inspected—
 - (i) the mortgage deeds and other securities belonging to the society;
or
 - (ii) where such mortgage deeds or securities have been registered with the Registrar General, copies thereof certified to be correct by the barrister or solicitor who prepared the same and the Registrar General’s receipts for their registration; and
- (c) state the number of properties with respect to which he has certified in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection that he actually inspected the mortgage deeds and other securities or copies thereof.”
