


AN ORDINANCE to amend the Beer Duties Ordinance,  
No. 251.

[25th November, 1921.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. Section 4 of the Beer Duties Ordinance, No. 251, is <sup>Duty on beer.</sup> hereby amended by substituting the words "eight and a half" for the word "five" in the sixth line thereof.
2. This Ordinance commenced on the 25th day of <sup>Commence-</sup> November, 1921. <sub>ment.</sub>
