AN ORDINANCE to amend the Brewery Ordinance,
Ch. 32. No. 10.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

Ch. 32. No. 10

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Brewery (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Brewery Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 27 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the expression "or deposited in a private warehouse pending exportation or shipment as ships' stores, or delivery therefrom, free of duty, for any other purpose approved by the Governor in Council," immediately after the expression "or shipped for use as ships' stores,".

Section 27 of

3. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the following section immediately after section 30:—

30A. The provisions of sections 28 and 29, and of subsections (1) and (2) of section 30 of this Ordinance shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to the deposit on drawback of locally brewed beer in a private warehouse pending exportation or shipment as ships' stores, or delivery therefrom, free of duty, for any other purpose approved by the Governor in Council, and, in the construction of the said provisions, and

- (a) references therein to exportation shall be deemed to include references to such deposit;
- (b) references therein to an exporter shall be deemed to include references to a person so depositing locally brewed beer;
- (c) reference in subsection (2) of the said section 28 to the place from which beer is exported, and in subsection (1) of the said section 30 to the port from which beer is shipped, shall be deemed to include reference to any such private warehouse; and
- (d) reference in subsection (1) of the said section 29 to production for shipment shall be deemed to include reference to such deposit."
