AN ORDINANCE to amend the Governor's Emoluments
Ordinance, Ch. 9. No. 1.

[1st January, 1958.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Governor's Emoluments (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Governor's Emoluments Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

7. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Customs Ordinance all goods as defined by section 2 thereof imported for use in the residence of the Governor or other officer administering the Government shall be exempt from the payment of import duties of Customs."
