1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Brewery (Amend- Short title.
ment) Ordinance, 1961, and shall be read as one with the

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting, after the definition of "sugar" occurring therein, the following definition :

" "Territory" means the Territory of Trinidad and Tobago;".

Section 33 of

3. Section 33 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by deleting the word "twelve" occurring therein and substituting therefor the word "six".

4. The Principal Ordinance is amended by deleting the word "Colony" wherever the said word occurs therein and substituting therefor the word "Territory".
