AN ACT to amend the Brewery Ordinance, Ch. 32 No. 10
[Assented to 7th March, 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Brewery (Amendment) ^{Short title}
Act, 1973.

Section 2
of Ch. 32
No. 10
amended

2. Section 2 of the Brewery Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by renumbering the section as section 2(1);
- (b) by inserting in its proper alphabetical order the following definition—

““other malt beverage” means any non-alcoholic brewed malt beverage.”

- (c) by adding immediately after section 2(1) as renumbered the following subsection—

“(2) The provisions of this Ordinance, except section 3(5), shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to other malt beverage as they apply to beer.”
