**Act No. 25 of 1995**

**AN ACT for the incorporation of the Kala Bhairava  
Foundation and matters incidental thereto**

*[Assented to 4th October, 1995]*

**WHEREAS** there has been established in Trinidad and Tobago an organization known as the Kala Bhairava Foundation: Preamble

**And** whereas it is expedient that the said Foundation be incorporated for the purposes herein set forth:

Enactment	ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:—
Short title	1. This Act may be cited as the Kala Bhairava Foundation (Incorporation) Act, 1995.
Incorporation	2. The Kala Bhairava Foundation (hereinafter called “The Foundation”) is hereby created a body corporate.
Aims and objects	3. The aims and objects of The Foundation are— <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) to promote the ideals of the Hindu Dharma amongst the public at large;</li><li>(b) to promote religious, cultural, educational and social activities in order to improve divine knowledge, strengthen spiritual faith, practise righteousness and foster peace, love and unity amongst the members and the public at large;</li><li>(c) to provide holistic healing for physical and mental illnesses;</li><li>(d) to establish and maintain educational centres;</li><li>(e) to provide facilities for spiritual and religious research;</li><li>(f) to provide assistance to the poor and to render humanitarian services;</li><li>(g) to acquire, erect and maintain such buildings the Foundation may deem necessary including monasteries, temples, halls, educational and yoga centres;</li><li>(h) to establish branch units in Trinidad and Tobago and in other countries;</li><li>(i) to do all such other things as are necessary or conducive to the attainment of the above aims and objects.</li></ol>

4. The Foundation shall have power—

Powers of the  
Organization

- (a) to acquire by purchase, transfer, donation, exchange, devise, bequest, grant, gift, conveyance or howsoever otherwise, any real or personal property or any estate or interest therein;
- (b) to accept surrenders of reconveyances and to enter into contracts;
- (c) to sell, exchange, devise, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal with all property which may from time to time be vested in it, subject to any restraint, reservation, or condition contained in the document under which it has acquired title.

5. All real or personal property of whatever nature now held by or vested in any person for the use and benefit of The Foundation is hereby transferred to and vested in The Foundation.

Transfer and vesting  
of property

6. All documents requiring the seal of The Foundation shall be sealed with the common seal of The Foundation in the presence of the President and Secretary for the time being in office (or in the event of incapacity or absence from the territory in the presence of some other person or persons authorised for that purpose by The Foundation) who shall both sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of The Foundation.

Mode of execution of  
documents

7. (1) The Foundation shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on it and that address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General within twenty-eight days of the incorporation or the change of address as the case may be.

Service of documents

(2) Every document to be served on The Foundation may be served by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to the registered address of the Foundation.

(3) Failure to register the address and any change thereof is a summary offence and renders The Foundation liable to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

Power to make rules

8. The Foundation may from time to time make rules for the proper conduct of its proceedings and discharge of its duties, powers and functions.

Saving of State and other rights

9. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of the State, or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any persons, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
