**Act No. 30 of 1994**

AN ACT to amend the Constitution of the Republic  
of Trinidad and Tobago

*[Assented to 23rd December, 1994]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution Short title  
(Amendment) Act, 1994.

Commence-  
ment

2. This Act comes into operation on such day as is fixed by the President by Proclamation.

Alteration of the  
Constitution

3. This Act shall be construed as altering the Constitution.

Section 127  
amended

4. Section 127 of the Constitution is amended by—

- (a) deleting the word “and” occurring in paragraph (b);
- (b) deleting the full stop at the end of paragraph (c) and substituting the following:
  - “; and”; and
- (c) inserting after paragraph (c) the following:
  - “(d) in the case of the Regional Health Authorities, to the Boards of the Regional Health Authorities.”.
