Act No. 36 of 1996

[L.S.]

AN ACT to supplement and vary the appropriation of the sum the issue of which was authorized by the Appropriation Act, 1996.

[Assented to 14th November, 1996]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Short title (Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation) (1996) Act, 1996.

Construction of
Act No. 1 of 1996

2. In this Act and in any other written law, a reference to the Appropriation Act, 1996, shall be construed as a reference to that Act as for the time being varied or otherwise amended by any Finance (Variation of Appropriation) Act, passed before this or that other written law.

Further issue of
\$15,206,000 from
Consolidated Fund

3. A further issue from the Consolidation Fund of the sum of fifteen million, two hundred and six thousand dollars is hereby authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1996 and appropriated in respect of Heads 46 and 51 of the Schedule to the Appropriation Act, 1996 entitled "Ministry of Sport and Youth Affairs" and "Ministry of Public Administration and Information" respectively.

Increase in Heads of
Expenditure
Schedule

4. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part I of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1996, are hereby increased by the amounts specified in the second column of that Part.

Reduction in Heads
of Expenditure

5. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1996, are hereby reduced by the amounts specified in the second column of that Part.

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, the sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1996, and unissued at the commencement of this Act may be utilised for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule.
