AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and Tobago
for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1971.

[Assented to 23rd December, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment.
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1971. Short title.

Fund authorised.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of four hundred and thirteen million, one hundred and eighty-eight thousand one hundred and eighty-two dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1971, under the heads of expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite to a head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of four hundred and thirteen million, one hundred and eighty-eight thousand one hundred and eighty-two dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that head in the Estimates for the said year.
