TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 9 of 1970

[L.S.]

AN ACT to authorise the payment of a gratuity and a pension to Alexander Holder, a former member of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Force.

[Assented to 20th March, 1970]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, **Enactment** by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Alexander Holder **Short title** (Special Gratuity and Pension) Act, 1970.

Payment of
gratuity and
pension
authorised

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, authority is hereby given for the payment out of the Consolidated Fund to Alexander Holder, a former member of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Force, of a gratuity in the sum of four thousand, five hundred and sixty-four dollars and six cents, and of a reduced pension payable monthly at the rate of one thousand and ninety-five dollars and thirty-eight cents per annum with effect from the 10th May, 1965.

Set-off amounts
already paid

3. Any sums paid before the commencement of this Act to the said Alexander Holder by way of pension and gratuity shall be set off against the sums to which he is entitled under section 2.

Payment of
balance of
gratuity and
pension

4. The balance of gratuity and any arrears of pension that becomes payable under this Act shall be paid from the provisions for Police pensions and gratuities under Head 15—Pensions and Gratuities, Ministry of Home Affairs and Personnel of the estimates of Trinidad and Tobago.

Repeal.

5. The Alexander Holder (Special Gratuity and Pension) Act 1966, is repealed.
