TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO
Act No. 3 of 1976

AN ACT to provide for the Incorporation of a body to be known as the Church of God Deliverance Centre of Trinidad and Tobago.

[Assented to 13th April, 1976]

WHEREAS there has been for many years established in the Territory a religious association known as the Church of God Deliverance Centre of Trinidad and Tobago (hereinafter called "the Church").

Preamble

And whereas it is expedient that the said Church should be incorporated for the purpose of exercising the powers hereinafter set forth.

Enactment

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same as follows :—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as The Church of God Deliverance Centre of Trinidad and Tobago (Incorporation) Act, 1975.

Incorporation

2. The Church shall be and is hereby created a body corporate.

Powers of
the Church

3. The Church shall have power :—

- (a) to acquire by purchase, exchange, gift, bequest, devise and otherwise, all messuages, lands tenements and hereditaments of any tenure and also all moneys, securities for money goods, or chattels whatsoever, and may hold and enjoy the same;
- (b) to accept surrenders and conveyances and to enter into contracts;
- (c) to sell, demise, grant, convey, mortgage, reconvey, surrender, exchange or otherwise dispose of all or any property from time to time vested in it.

Transfer and
Vesting of lands

4. All churches, chapels, mission houses, vicarages lands and buildings formerly belonging to the Church of God Deliverance Centre of Trinidad and Tobago are hereby vested and appropriated to the use of the Church.

Mode of execution
of documents

5. All documents requiring the seal of the Church of God Deliverance Centre of Trinidad and Tobago shall be sealed with the common seal of the Church in the presence of two of the trustees of the Church and its General Secretary for the time being in office who shall sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and the same is the lawful seal of the Church.

6. The Church shall at all times have a permanent address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on the Church and such address shall be registered with the Registrar General. All documents to be served on the Church may be served by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to the address so registered.

Service of
documents on the

7. The Church may make rules for the proper conduct of its proceedings and discharge of its duties and any such rules may be varied or revoked or added to by the association.

Rules

8. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of Her Majesty, Her Heirs or Successors, or of any bodies public or corporate or of any other persons, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
