TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 58 of 1975

AN ACT to make special provision for the payment of a contract gratuity to Romeo Huggins former Medical Officer I in the Ministry of Health.

*[Assented to 18th December, 1975]*

BE ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by <sup>Enactment</sup> and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Romeo Huggins (Contract Gratuity) Act, 1975. <sup>Short title</sup>

Authority to  
pay gratuity  
to Romeo Huggins

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of gratuity there shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund to Romeo Huggins, a former Medical Officer I in the Ministry of Health, a gratuity in the sum of nineteen thousand and twenty dollars.
