AN ACT to amend the Pensions Extension Ordinance, 1961.

[Assented to 20th October, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup>  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House  
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the  
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions Extension <sup>Short title</sup>  
(Amendment) Act, 1972.

2. The Pensions Extension Ordinance, 1961, is amended by repealing and replacing section 8 thereof as follows:—

Variation of  
Schedule

8. (1) The Governor-General may by notice published in the *Gazette* vary the Schedule—

(a) by including therein any other statutory board or removing therefrom any statutory board; and

(b) by adding thereto any other office in the public service or under a statutory board or removing therefrom any such office.

(2) Where a statutory board that has been included in the Schedule establishes a Pension Scheme for the benefit of its officers such statutory board and the offices thereunder shall be removed from the Schedule by the Governor-General.”

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 4th of July, 1967.
