Act No. 24 of 1979

AN ACT to provide for the Incorporation of the Trinidad
and Tobago Automobile Association.

[Assented to 16th July, 1979]

WHEREAS there has been established in Trinidad and ^{Preamble}
Tobago an Association known as the Trinidad and
Tobago Automobile Association:

And Whereas it is expedient that the said Trinidad
and Tobago Automobile Association be incorporated:

Enactment	BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago, as follows:—
Short title	1. This Act may be cited as the Trinidad and Tobago Automobile Association (Incorporation) Act, 1979.
Incorporation	2. The Trinidad and Tobago Automobile Association (hereinafter referred to as “the Association”) is hereby created a body corporate.
Aims and objects	3. The aims and objects of the Association are— (a) to protect and advance the interests of motorists, including motor cyclists; (b) to establish reciprocal relationships between similar organisations throughout the world; (c) to render free of charge both legal assistance and advice to members involved in road accidents or charged with traffic offences; (d) to provide members with a roadside breakdown service for their vehicles; (e) to effect insurances for the benefit of members as the association shall consider appropriate; and (f) to provide a touring service for members wishing to motor abroad.
Mode of execution of documents	4. All documents requiring the seal of the Association shall be sealed with the common seal in the presence of its President and Secretary who shall both sign every such document and such signing shall be <i>prima facie</i> evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the Association.
Service of documents on the Corporation	5. (1) The Association shall have a fixed address for the service of documents on the Association and that address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General within twenty-eight days of the date of incorporation or the change of address as the case may be. (2) All documents to be served on the Association may be served by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered address of the Association.

(3) Failure to register the address or any change thereof is a summary offence and renders the Association liable to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction thereof. Saving of State and other rights

6. Nothing in this Act shall affect the rights of the State or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any other persons except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
