Act No. 24 of 1980

AN ACT to provide for the confirmation of Grafton Woodley, deceased, in his appointment as Electrical Foreman, in the Ministry of Government Construction and Maintenance.

[Assented to 20th May, 1980]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the Grafton Woodley, Short title deceased (Confirmation of Appointment) Act, 1980.

2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, Grafton Woodley who died on the 6th April, 1979, is hereby deemed to have been confirmed in his appointment as Electrical Foreman, in the Ministry of Government Construction and Maintenance with effect from the 16th March, 1977.
