AN ACT to provide for the confirmation of appointment of George Scott, former Cleaner I, Ministry of Finance and for the payment of superannuation benefits to the said George Scott.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the George Scott (Con- Short title firmation of Appointment and Superannuation Benefits) Act, 1977.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary—

- (a) George Scott, former Cleaner I, Ministry of Finance shall be deemed to have been confirmed in his appointment as Cleaner I with effect from the 1st day of July, 1971, and to have retired on his attaining the age of sixty years on the 24th day of November, 1975;
- (b) there shall be paid from the Consolidated Fund to the said George Scott a gratuity of four thousand, seven hundred and forty-six dollars and a reduced pension, payable monthly, with effect from the 24th day of November, 1975, at the rate of one thousand, one hundred and thirty-nine dollars and four cents per annum.
